Guidelines for Parade Participants

- 1. Application/harmless agreement should be mailed in as soon as possible. You may email (lwilliamson@wvstateu.edu) or fax them to (304) 766-4292.
- 2. Participants are responsible for providing their own transportation/vehicles for their parade unit.
- 3. Each entry shall be in "good taste" and shall, in the opinion of the Parade Committee, add beauty and interest from the public point of view.
- 4. Each entry will display a sign or banner indicating affiliation.
- 5. Floats should bear the name of the community, organization, company or individual responsible for its entrance in the parade on the side.
- 6. Participants must take and keep place assigned by the Parade Committee until the parade's official termination.
- 7. Please keep a distance of one (1) car length between you and the entry in front of you. Committee members will assist in this area.
- 8. The parade begins at Shawnee Park. You will be checked in by a committee member.
- 9. The parade travels through the middle of West Virginia State University on the brick road.
- 10. The parade ends at Dickerson Stadium (you will be directed to turn right to exit the area).

West Virginia State University Homecoming Parade Day Rules & Regulations

- 1. Participants should arrive at Shawnee Park no later than 9:30 a.m.
- 2. The parade will begin at 10:30 a.m. sharp.
- 3. Check in will be at the park entrance.
- 4. If you need to line up with another unit, please be sure to list that unit on your application. If you will be riding in a vehicle with another unit, please list that unit on your application.
- 5. **Drivers (of buses and other pertinent vehicles)**, after dropping off participants, may find parking near the Walker Convocation Center, Erickson Alumni, Sullivan Hall, or another lot on campus.
- 6. Units **may perform** as they are marching. A unit **may not stop** to perform unless the entire parade has otherwise stopped.
- 7. **Safety of our parade participants and crowd** is of utmost concern. Each parade participating group must be responsible not only for their own safety, but also for the safety of the public audience around them.
- 8. Vehicle drivers are solely responsible for the safe operation of their vehicle.
- 9. Participants must obey uniformed police officers and/or parade marshals at all times.
- 10. No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances of any kind will be allowed in the staging area, in any vehicle, on any float or on the person of any parade participant. This will not be acceptable or tolerated throughout the parade.
- 11. Parade groups with horse or animals of any kind **must each provide people** to perform **immediate "pooper scooper" duties**.
- 12. Your group may not in any way solicit funds from the parade audience.
- 13. There must be at least 1 adult for every 10 children under 12 years old. There must be at least 1 adult for every 20 children between the ages of 13 & 17.
- 14. All float materials must be flame retardant.
- 15. All **wiring must be** properly secured to prevent mechanical damage and injury to float riders.
- 16. Windshields of vehicles **must not be totally covered** to obscure the vision of the driver.
- 17. Failure, by any participant or parents of participants, to obey any police officer or parade official will be cause for an entry to be removed from the parade.
