A dedication and opening ceremony was held Friday, Feb. 28, for the new D. Stephen and Diane H. Walker Convocation Center at West Virginia State University and the Center was open for the first time to the public on March 1.

The Convocation Center is named in honor of longtime Kanawha Valley civic leaders D. Stephen and Diane H. Walker and features a 1,350-seat-arena and athletic court as well as a bronze statue of alumnus Earl Lloyd in the lobby.
